NEVADA HOUSING COALITION LAUNCHES STATEWIDE SUPPORTIVE HOUSING ONLINE TOOLKIT IN PARTNERSHIP WITH CSH

LAS VEGAS, NV – The Nevada Housing Coalition (NHC) is proud to announce the launch of the [Nevada Supportive Housing Online Resource Toolkit](#), a digital resource designed to strengthen understanding, expand capacity, and accelerate the development of supportive housing across the state.

Developed in partnership with Corporation for Supportive Housing (CSH), a national nonprofit that helps communities advance supportive housing through technical guidance, the toolkit is the result of nearly 10 months of collaboration, bringing together national expertise and local insight to address Nevada’s urgent housing challenges.

NHC’s mission is to promote the development and preservation of affordable housing for all Nevadans through collaboration, education, and advocacy. This new online resource reflects that mission by serving as a central hub of information and practical tools for a wide range of stakeholders including housing advocates, policymakers, healthcare providers, nonprofit organizations, developers, and community leaders.

“CSH is proud to partner with NHC to launch Nevada's first-ever supportive housing resource toolkit,” said Juawana Grant, Director, Southwest at CSH. “This online resource has been thoughtfully designed to address Nevada’s specific supportive housing needs, offering education and advocacy tools that leverage CSH’s 35+ years of expertise. With actionable strategies, in-depth insights, and tailored resources, this toolkit equips policymakers, advocates, and stakeholders with the tools needed to tackle the housing and homelessness crisis. CSH and NHC are steadfast in their commitment to fostering innovative, scalable supportive housing solutions that create meaningful, lasting change in Nevada's communities.”

Nevada faces a severe shortage of affordable housing, with only 16 affordable units available for every 100 extremely low-income households. This shortage contributes to rising homelessness and deepening disparities among the state’s most vulnerable populations.

Supportive housing is an evidence-based approach that combines affordable housing with coordinated services. The toolkit will cover an overview of supportive housing and its current role in Nevada. It will also give insights into the economic and health benefits of supportive housing, highlight impact metrics and success stories, and provide resources and references to expand this solution across the state.

“This toolkit represents what’s possible when strong partnerships come together with a shared purpose,” said Maurice Page, Executive Director of NHC. “Through our collaboration with CSH, we’ve created a resource that not only educates but empowers stakeholders across Nevada to take meaningful action. At its core, this work is about expanding access to safe, stable housing and ensuring that communities have the knowledge and tools needed to make that a reality for all Nevadans.”

To celebrate the launch, NHC will host CSH at its monthly virtual Lunch & Learn on Wednesday, April 22nd at 12:00pm PT. Entitled, “Partnering for Impact: CSH & Nevada’s Supportive Housing Toolkit,” this session will provide a guided tour of the toolkit and light training on how to use the new online resource.
